ODJFS Rule of The Month

5101:2-7-09 (D)



Care, Supervision and Discipline

A foster caregiver shall not subject a foster child to verbal abuse or swearing; to derogatory remarks about foster children, their families, their races, their sex, their religion, their color or their national origin; or to threats of physical violence or removal from the foster home.
