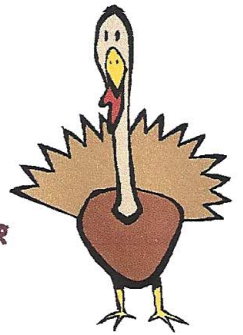

5101:2-7-11 (C)



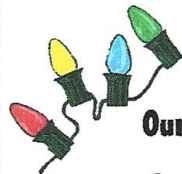
